

before specified that he ^{was} not called into
 service again until the latter part of 1779
 and was stationed at ^{Ferryburg} Petersburg in South
 Carolina under the command of the same
 Captain and Colo as aforesaid and under the
 command of Genl ^{Lincoln} Lincoln the
 length of time he served during that time
 he does not distinctly recollect but
 it was until the arrival of the British
 at Savannah that he was then
 called into service for a short time but
 was again called into service about four
 weeks afterwards and was marched down
 to Savannah and after arriving there two days
 after the attack was made on Savannah
 by the French and Americans he was
 marched from Savannah to Petersburg
 under the command of Colo ^{Lincoln} Lincoln and
 Captain Garrison and remained at Petersburg
 about one month when he was relieved
 from further duty at that time he
 was called into service again in about two
 months under the same officers and
 acted on the Savannah river and continued
 to perform duty as aforesaid
 until Charles town fell into
 the possession of the British he then
 went into North Carolina and joined
 Genl Sumners army in the year 1780
 he joined Captain Gennets company
 and remained in Genl Sumners army
 up to the time of his defeat on
 Cananba river that ^{of Gen Sumners} Sumners defeat
 he was again in service ^{until he} Captain Gennet's
 company before the battle of Kings
 mountain and that he was in Captain
 Gennet's company at the battle of 1792
